The maximum order volume per translator is based on a DIN standard page at 90 minutes. By waiving additional charges, finetext Germany demands in total about 30-50% less per order for express translations than its competitors.

'We consider the prices of some of our competitors to be out of date,' explains Enrico Jochen. 'The success of finetext Germany is based on the combination of innovative ideas and competitive quotations.'

In contrast to special conditions in master agreements, the new express quotations from finetext Germany can be booked without a master agreement or minimum contract term.

finetext Germany provides its translation services mainly via the internet. This results in cost savings, which can also be passed to the client.
